LARGE ITEM DISPOSAL

ACCEPTED ITEMS

Refrigerators/freezers/air conditioners/dehumidifiers/appliances*, batteries (A-D only), bikes, cardboard, furniture, lawn furniture, mattresses, microwaves, scrap metal, textiles, tires**,toilets, sinks, other bulky items, Electronics such as computers, laptops, flat panel monitors, phones, VCRs, DVD players, flat screen TVs, stereos.

* ALL Appliances must have certified "freon-removed" stickers to be accepted (includes air conditioners & dehumidifiers). Residents can pay \$25 (cash) per appliance to have Freon removed at this event.

** LIMIT OF 7 TIRES PER ADDRESS

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

We cannot accept: CRT TVs or Monitors***, household hazardous waste (gasoline, used oil, chemicals), any kind of Paint or paint cans, commercial waste, dirt or yard waste, concrete/asphalt, bricks, construction debris, regular household garbage, wooden console TVs, cars or other motorized vehicles, or more than 7 Tires per household.



***Due to changes in Michigan Law, CRT televisions and monitors can no longer be recycled for free of charge. A CRT is the older style TV with tubes in the back (they're usually very heavy). Residents are encouraged to contact retail sellers of TVs, as many still offer free recycling for older televisions.

ON-SITE SHREDDING

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS FOR SHREDDING

Shredding takes place on-site during this event for complete security. Acceptable materials include: Junk mail, bank statements, cancelled checks, contracts, paper, manila folders, credit card statements, taxes, etc. There is limited space available; once truck is full, no more shredding will be accepted.
