LARGE ITEM DISPOSAL

ACCEPTED ITEMS

Refrigerators/freezers/air conditioners/dehumidifiers/appliances*, batteries (A-D only), bikes, furniture, lawn furniture, mattresses, microwaves, scrap metal, textiles, tires**, toilets, sinks, other bulky items, Electronics: computers, laptops, flat screen monitors or TVs, phones, VCRs, DVD players, stereos.

* Appliances must have certified "freon-removed" sticker to be accepted (includes air conditioners & dehumidifiers). If no sticker, residents must pay \$25 cash per appliance for Freon removal.

** LIMIT OF 7 TIRES PER ADDRESS

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

NO: CRT/tube TVs or Monitors, household hazardous waste (gasoline, used oil, chemicals), any kind of Paint or paint cans, commercial waste, dirt or yard waste, concrete/asphalt, bricks, construction debris, regular household garbage, cars or other motorized vehicles, or more than 7 Tires per household. Call the Township if you're not sure about bringing an item.



Due to changes in Michigan Law, CRT televisions & monitors are considered hazardous materials and must be properly recycled. They are not accepted at this event. A CRT is the older style TV with a tube inside and leaded glass. Residents are encouraged to contact retail sellers of TVs, as some offer recycling services for a nominal fee.



Limit 7 Tires per address

ON-SITE SHREDDING

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS FOR SHREDDING

Shredding takes place on-site during this event. Acceptable materials include: junk mail, bank & credit card statements, cancelled checks, contracts, manila folders, taxes, etc. Only residential paper is accepted; NO binders, plastic folders, metal (staples in papers is OK). There is limited space available; once truck is full, no more shredding can be accepted.
